Subject: PFAS Chemicals and Drinking Water

To Whom this May Concern,

PFAS are a group of manufactured chemicals that have been used in industry and consumer products since the 1940s. Current scientific research suggests that exposure to high levels of certain PFAS grouped chemicals may lead to adverse health outcomes. In 2014, EPA issued interim updated drinking water health advisories for perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA) and perfluorooctane sulfonic acid (PFOS). In June 2022 added five new chemicals. The five PFAS additions include: hexafluoropropylene oxide dimer acid and its ammonium salt (HFPO-DA – sometimes referred to as GenX chemicals), perfluorooctanesulfonic acid (PFOS), perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA), perfluorononanoic acid (PFNA), and perfluorohexanesulfonic acid (PFHxS). These actions build on EPA's progress to safeguard communities from PFAS pollution and scientifically inform upcoming efforts, including EPA's forthcoming proposed National Primary Drinking Water Regulation for PFOA and PFOS, which EPA will release in the fall of 2022. In addition to the listed chemicals that the EPA is not monitoring, the EPA has also listed potential PFAS chemicals that need more research. https://comptox.epa.gov/dashboard/chemical-lists/EPAPFASRL

As of this letter none of R&R Lotion's formulations contain any of the ingredients that are on the PFAS list. We will continue to monitor the PFAS regulations for any new chemicals and compare any newly listed chemicals with the raw materials in our finished products and communicate this information to our customers. R&R Lotion is committed to helping local and national efforts to keeping our water clean by making sustainable choices when sourcing our ingredients and formulating its products.
