Subject: REACH Compliance

To Whom this May Concern,

REACH stands for Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals. It is a regulation of the European Union, adopted to improve the protection of human health and the environment from the risks that can be posed by chemicals. Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 originated in the European Union and restricts the use of specific hazardous materials). All manufacturers and importers of chemicals must identify and manage risks linked to the substances they manufacture and market. Substances that may have serious effects on human health and the environment can be identified as substances of very high concern (SVHCs). These are primarily substances which are carcinogenic, mutagenic or toxic to reproduction as well as substances with persistent and bio-accumulative characteristics. The candidate list of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) that are subject to authorization was released by ECHA. Additional substances are regularly added to this list and published by the ECHA.
